President Ilham Aliyev has signed an order on the celebration of the 100th anniversary of Azerbaijan Democratic Republic.


May 28, 2018 will mark the centenary of Azerbaijan Democratic Republic, the first parliamentary republic in the East.

Accordingly, the Ministry calls all foreign nationals to refrain themselves from traveling to or doing business with the occupied territories in and around the Nagorno-Karabakh region of the Republic of Azerbaijan.

The Ministry would like to remind that those people and companies will be denied the entry to or doing business in Azerbaijan.
